

# WATERFORD BOROUGH TRANSIENT LICENSE FEE EXEMPTION REQUEST FORM

Section 2901(a) of the Pennsylvania Borough Code authorizes boroughs to regulate and license transient merchants engaged in any transient retail business within the borough.

Chapter 188 of Waterford Borough's ordinances requires transient retail businesses to obtain a transient retail business license and pay the license fee to obtain such license. This applies to door to door sales, roadside stands, and sales on public property.

Section 2901(a)(3) of the Pennsylvania Borough Code exempts certain businesses from paying a license fee.

I hereby assert that I am a qualified exempt business and certify that I am:

- A farmer selling the farmer's own produce.
- A person selling personal property if the proceeds of the sale are to be applied to a charitable or philanthropic purpose.
- A manufacturer or producer in the sale of bread or bakery products.
- A manufacturer or producer in the sale of meat or meat products.
- A manufacturer or producer in the sale of milk or milk products (not including ice cream or other frozen desserts).
