- *2009 International did not sell for \$30,000*
- *Jeff moved to advertise 2009 International for \$25,000 with a bid ending date of December 5<sup>th</sup>, Second by Michele. Motion carried*
- *West Fourth Street Bridge is on a six-month inspection, If nothing is done the bridge will end up being closed*
- *Mark Corey looked at the bridge project and is willing to apply for Act 13 for the replacement of the bridge with an aluminum box culvert bridge (three of these bridges have been placed in McKane Township). With a life span of 50-75 years.*
- *Michele motioned to hire the professional services of Mark J Corey & Associates in the amount of \$35,000 to manage all aspects and engineering of replacing West 4<sup>th</sup> Street bridge.*
- *Key points of the discussion include- Mark Corey & Associates will apply for all grants and permits; they will manage all aspects of the project- Borough staff is for support purposes only; major factor with the project is receiving a \$250K Act 13 grant; billing will not begin until post grant approval, If any endangered plants or wildlife are found A biologist will conduct a study in the spring.*
- *Michele moved to put Sarah and Jeff as the grant Authorizers, Second by Steph. Jeff Abstained, Motion carried*
